CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PLAYERS

- Play by the Rules and within the spirit of the game.
- Do not argue with the match official. Accept all decisions from the referee without argument or comment. All disputes to be referred to your team RTO who will decide what action, if any, to be taken.
- Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials or other players, deliberately distracting or provoking another person is not acceptable or permitted in any sport
- Maintain your focus and work hard for yourself and your team
- Be a good sport and be prepared to acknowledge good play whether it is from your team or the opposition
- Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player
- Cooperate with your coach, teammates and opponents. Without them, there would be no competition. No abuse will be tolerated. This action may result in suspension.
- Play for your own enjoyment, and not just to please parents and coaches
- Remove all jewellery prior to training and match play, as it is a hazard to you and those around you
- Do not accept or use any banned or unauthorized drugs, including the consumption of alcohol at any time
- Repeated offences or bad behavior will be referred to the Executive Committee of Peakhurst United FC and may result in you being required to appear before that committee to explain your actions. The Committee will determine the appropriate penalty.
